You should be flexible and able to adapt to different job conditions. Learning is ongoing but informal at this time. Individual initiative is welcome. Prior handyman or maintenance experience is helpful, but not required.

The successful applicant will be asked to pass a COVID-19 test, and a Physical Health Screening of some sort. Reference will be checked.

CULTURE of CTTB

CTTB is a unique organization. Members come from a variety of cultures around the world. Some are monastics, some are students, some are volunteers. Residents are primarily here for some spiritual reason. In interacting with this community, paid staff are expected to respect this and, at a minimum, observe the rules of the community while working here - wear modest clothing, refrain from smoking, drinking, intentional killing of pests/insects, or eating of nonvegetarian food while on the campus. Safety is also a paramount concern.

HOURS of WORK

40 hours a week from Monday to Friday.
